John 3:1-21



Lesson Objective

PRAYER

Who came to give us life (echo)



Show us ways to share your love (echo)

BIBLE STORY

This lesson will help children explore the story of Nicodemus. Nicodemus had heard about Jesus, and knew Jesus was from God; he wanted to know more. But he was afraid of what people might say and do if they saw him, so he came to visit Jesus at night.

Name pronunciations are in bold brackets after the first time a character's name appears.

The Story



Today's story happened late at night. A man named Nicodemus (Nick-oh-DEEM-us) had heard about Jesus. He also heard that many people didn't like what he was saying about God. He decided to visit Jesus. He wanted to talk with Jesus and find out what he had to say about God.

Nicodemus didn't want anyone to see him visiting Jesus. So he went very quietly to where Jesus was staying late at night. It was very dark so no one could see Nicodemus visit Jesus.

Jesus sat with Nicodemus and they talked a long time. Nicodemus had a lot of questions. Jesus explained a lot of things to him.

Jesus told him that God could give him a whole new life. Nicodemus didn't understand at first. How could he have a new life? Did he have to change his name?



Did he have to move to a new town? How could he become a child of God now that he was all grown up?

- Day/Night and Light/Dark



Butterfly Puppet

Difficulty: Medium



STEP 1 Put out two paper plates, a chenille stem, markers, clear tape, scissors and a hole punch for your children.

Supplies needed:

- Paper plates,
- Chenille stems,
- Markers,
- Clear tape,
- Scissors,
- Hole punch,
- Stickers,
- Glue

STEP 2 Fold one paper plate in half with the eating side to the outside. Cut the other paper plate in half. Cut a strip about 1 inch wide off the cut edge of each half plate.





STEP 3 Colour the butterfly. Add any decorations you would like such as stickers or glitter glue. Punch two holes in the head and insert a chenille stem for the antenna.

STEP 4 Tape one of the paper plate halves to the underside of the butterfly. Have the eating side facing the bottom of the plate. Do the same for the other side. This will make 2 pockets for your fingers. Put the butterfly on your hands with your fingers in one pocket and your thumb in the other. Fly away with new life!




Day and Night/Light and Darkness



Difficulty Level: Easy

STEP 1 Put out a Sun and a Moon Sheet, a craft stick, markers, glue and scissors for your children.

STEP 2 Colour each picture and cut them out. Glue the sun and moon back to back on the craft stick. Go from darkness to light with Nicodemus!







ACTIVITIES

In this section, you will find fun activities to do with your children. These are good, active games to help children move around and get out their energy before quieting down again. Many of these games require multiple kids, and a larger group for the Cotton Ball Relay.

Cotton Ball Relay


Divide the children into two or three teams. Place a pile of cotton balls at one end of the play area. Place a paper plate at the other end of the play area, and have the teams line up in front of the cotton balls. Give the first child on each team two straws.

The children will use the straws like chop sticks. Show them how to hold them between their fingers. If they aren't able to hold them like that, they may use one straw in each hand.

Each child on the team will use the straws to pick up a cotton ball. The cotton ball will be pinched between the two straws. Then they carry it to their team's paper plate. Once they place it on the plate, they run back to their team and give the straws to the next team member.

No hands are allowed to be used to pick up any dropped cotton balls or to put the cotton ball

between the straws. If someone drops a cotton ball on the way, they can only use their straws to pick it up!

You could choose to give each team the same number of cotton balls, and see which team can put them on the plates first. You can also tell the teams they have a certain amount of time to get as many cotton balls on their plate as possible! Count the balls to see who has the most

Have extra straws available in case any get damaged and can't be used any longer.


This game is popular in Columbia. Columbia is located in the north west of South America.

Have all the children stand in a group. Choose one child to be the caller. The caller holds a ball while the other players move around the caller.

The caller throws the ball in the air and then calls the name of another player. The named player must try to catch the ball before it hits the ground while the other players run away.

If the player catches the ball, they count to three and then throw the ball in the air while calling another player's name. This continues until a player misses catching the ball.



When they miss the ball, they call "Stop!" The rest of the players must then stand still. They can move their body but must not move their feet.

The player must retrieve the ball and then try to hit any other player on the legs with the ball. A player who is hit becomes the new caller. If the thrower misses, they become the new caller.


